GENERATORprojects TAKE-OVER AND GENERAL SPACE USE

Between programmed exhibitions the committee encourages members to requests to use the two large white spaces for 'take-over' events and the development of work such as filming, documentation or trial installs. If you would like to make use of the white spaces at Generator Projects please send the committee an email. This use of space is done on a trust basis with the only stipulations being that the space and equipment are returned as found and a £15 returnable deposit is paid for keys. We also encourage a payment in-kind system towards the continued running of the space. All requests will be dependant on the requirements of the funded programme schedule and it should be noted that there will be limited committee assistance during these periods. These slots are designed as artist-led activity, and are not part of the funded programme.

Note: Although Generator is not a funding body nor the committee specialists in writing applications, the committee can assist individuals in putting together an application towards funding an event within GENERATORprojects when given an ample time frame.

MEMBERspace USE

The MEMBERspace is very much still under development. However, through-out the funded programme this space will be dedicated to hosting side events and exhibiting members work that relate to the curatorial themes of presented shows. There is a small section of the funded budget set aside to cover costs and provide modest project fees to members who wish to take up this offer.

Between the programme schedule, the space is available to use on request by members to host both public-facing events/workshops or to use generally as a versatile space to work collaboratively with others. Members are free to use any facilities available in this space including research resources, limited equipment, free wifi and the kitchen area which includes donation-based coffee and tea supplies. Over the course of the year, the committee will be working towards improving the resources available in this area through the purchasing of extended resource materials, equipment and improved accessibility to our archival material. The committee will also be working with an artist-in-residence, Henri Meadows, to develop the space through-out 2014.
